## **DISASTER MANAGEMENT POLICY**

### **Objectives**

- To establish a framework for effective disaster preparedness, response and recovery efforts on campus.
- To ensure the safety and security of individuals and property during emergencies.
- To promote awareness, education and training on disaster management among the college community.

### **Policy Statements**

- The college will conduct regular risk assessments to identify potential hazards and vulnerabilities on campus.
- Comprehensive disaster management plans will be developed, reviewed and updated periodically to address various types of emergencies, including fires, hazardous material spills, natural disasters and security incidents.
- Emergency notification systems, including text alerts and public address systems, will be utilized to disseminate timely information and instructions to the college community during emergencies.
- The college will provide support services and resources to assist individuals and communities affected by disasters, including counselling, medical assistance and temporary housing.

### **Implementation**

All members of the college community are expected to familiarize themselves with and adhere to the provisions of this policy.
