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RESEARCH POLICY



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The Research policy is a critical document that encourages research endeavours at Kuriakose Elias College. It aims to support and enhance the quality of research while ensuring that all research activities align with the institution's values and goals. The policy is designed to guide faculty and students in conducting research that contributes to knowledge generation, addresses societal needs and enhances the institution's academic reputation.

Objectives

- Promotes and supports high-quality research that contributes to academic excellence and societal development
- Ensures that all research activities adhere to ethical standards and legal requirements
- Facilitates the dissemination of research findings through publications, conferences and other scholarly platforms
- Encourages interdisciplinary and collaborative research within and outside the institution
- Provides a supportive environment for researchers, including access to resources, training and mentorship

Policy Guidelines

- All research proposals must be submitted to the Research Committee for approval before commencing the research
- Researchers must conduct their work with honesty, integrity and transparency
- Plagiarism and other forms of academic misconduct are strictly prohibited and subject to disciplinary action
- Researchers are encouraged to seek external funding for their projects. The Research Committee will assist in identifying funding opportunities and preparing applications for grant
- Research funds must be used in accordance with the terms and conditions of the funding body and the institution's financial policies
- The institution encourages collaborative research with other academic institutions, industry partners and governmental organizations
- All collaborative research agreements must be reviewed and approved by the Research Committee to protect the institution's interests



- Researchers must acknowledge the affiliation and support of Kuriakose Elias College in all publications and presentations
- The college will provide ongoing training and development opportunities to enhance researcher's skills and knowledge
- The Research Committee will organize workshops, seminars and conferences to foster research activities and collaboration within the institution
- This research policy will be periodically reviewed by the Research Committee to ensure its relevance and effectiveness
- Amendments to the policy will be based on feedback from stakeholders and changes in the research landscape
- The Research Committee is responsible for implementing, monitoring and reviewing the policy

Implementation

This policy applies to all research activities conducted by faculty and students of Kuriakose Elias College, Mannanam. It covers all disciplines and research areas within the institution and extends to partnerships and collaborations with external organizations, institutions and industry. The Research Committee of the college will provide guidance, support and oversight to ensure that research activities are conducted in accordance with the policy guidelines. The Research Committee will also address any issues or challenges related to research and recommend amendments to the policy as needed.
