## SCHOLARSHIP AND ENDOWMENTS POLICY

Scholarship policies in arts and science colleges aim to provide financial assistance and support to deserving students. Kuriakose Elias College, Mannanam always tries to provide a dynamic learning environment that empowers our students to achieve their academic and personal aspirations.

### Objectives

### Policy Statements

- Enable students to take advantage of various scholarship schemes.
- Assist students in applying for scholarships at the central, state and institutional levels, as well as from other schemes such as ICCR, alumni, sports, etc.
- Scrutinize the documents and recommend them accordingly.
- Conduct regular follow-ups on the processing of each submitted application and update the requisite documents.
- A scholarship committee, comprising of a group of faculty members and office staff, continually observes and evaluates all the matters related to the scholarship.

### Implementation

K. E. college makes sure that our students are provided with clear instructions and assistance to apply for grants and scholarships provided by the central and state governments. Once the scholarship is officially announced, the scholarship committee effectively communicates the scholarship details to the students. This is done through various channels such as the college website, notice boards, student handbooks and orientation sessions. The college administration maintains open lines of communication with students regarding the eligibility criteria, scholarship amounts, supporting documents, types of scholarships available, the application process and key deadlines. If the policy includes renewable scholarships, the college has an established process for monitoring the academic performance or other conditions required for renewal. The policy clearly outlines the criteria for scholarship renewal, the timeline for evaluating renewal applications and any consequences or appeals process for non-renewal.
